






Figure 2. V_{CE(sat)} vs. I_C

Figure 3. DC Current Gain




Figure 4. Output Capacitance

Figure 5. Output Current vs. Input Voltage




Figure 6. Input Voltage vs. Output Current





Figure 7. V_{CE(sat)} vs. I_C

Figure 8. DC Current Gain







Figure 11. Input Voltage vs. Output Current


