


General Description

This N-Channel MOSFET is produced using Fairchild Semiconductor's advanced Power Trench[®] process. Advancements in both silicon and Dual CoolTM package technologies have been combined to offer the lowest $r_{DS(on)}$ while maintaining excellent switching performance by extremely low Junction-to-Ambient thermal resistance. This device has the added benefit of an efficient monolithic Schottky body diode.







SyncFET Schottky body diode Characteristics




Figure 14. FDMS3006S SyncFET body diode reverse recovery characteristic

Fairchild's SyncFET process embeds a Schottky diode in parallel with PowerTrench MOSFET. This diode exhibits similar characteristics to a discrete external Schottky diode in parallel with a MOSFET. Figure 14 shows the reverse recovery characteristic of the FDMS3006S.

Schottky barrier diodes exhibit significant leakage at high temperature and high reverse voltage. This will increase the power in the device.





Figure 15. SyncFET body diode reverse leakage versus drain-source voltage





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
